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Description of the problem/exercise: Continue the chain

Type: Games in which blind people can participate on an equal footing with other players

12 elements of each set with three different base forms are used. One of the players put one element on the table. The chain can be continued (in four directions if the first element is a square, in three directions if the first element is a triangle and in two directions if the first element is a circle) by linking another element with total side connection. The winner is the person who plays his last element.

- Why this exercise is good: Competences that are developed and knowledge, which is deepening: empathy for other people, creativity, problem solving, communication skills, collaboration skills and organizational skills.
