

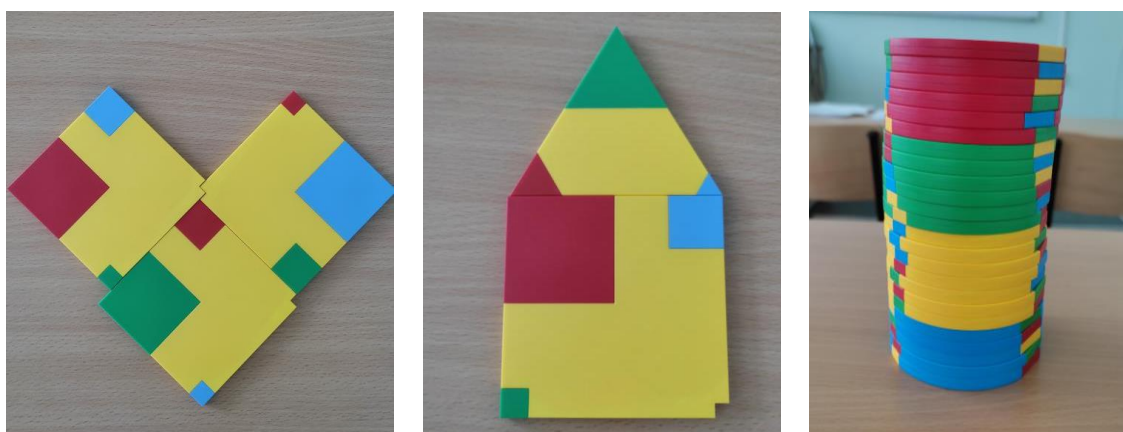

Description of the problem / exercise: **Learning a second language**

Flower – English, Flor – Spanish, Cvet – Serbian, Virág – Hungarian

Star – English, Estrella – Spanish, Zvezda – Serbian, Csillag - Hungarian
