Description of the problem / exercise: **Find the elements!**

Guided Game Ideas in Kindergarten.

The purpose of the game: Find (for example) the elements that have the smallest green surface.

Making the game harder: For older kids, multiple packages can be used at the same time. For example, after finding all the elements that have the smallest green surface, they can lay out a model.

Target audience: For all ages

Duration: Variable

Number of players: Alone, in pairs or in smaller groups.



- *Why this exercise is good:* While playing, children can learn the skill of counting, the colours, shapes, mathematical collective terms. Their ability of observation, visual and logical thinking develops.
- *Which level is recommended:* Kindergarten, elementary school
